Who we are-

Community Volunteers in Medicine (CVIM) is a community-based, volunteer nonprofit organization providing primary medical and dental care. A team of 250 volunteer licensed healthcare professionals and support volunteers care for their neighbors in need. CVIM employs a small core staff of full and part-time professionals to ensure continuity of care. 62% of our patients are Hispanic and many of our volunteers and staff, bilingual.

What we do-

CVIM provides free medical and dental services and prescription medicine for eligible uninsured, low-income adults and children in Chester County, enabling them to continue to be contributing members of the community.

Internship Objectives

By utilizing the student's oral and written Spanish skills, this affords students the ability to communicate with native Spanish speakers in real-life situations within a medical and dental office. This may include, but not limited to:

- Assistance with registration
- Making patient reminder calls and waiting list calls
- Scheduling and confirming appointments
- Assistance with referrals and communication with agencies that can assist patients
- Medical and dental interpretation with the practitioner if the student's Spanish is proficient enough with medical terminology
